The Role

- Being a point of contact between the global team and the regional team
- Being the external point of contact for the EMEA region
- Representing the interests of the EMEA regional team at a global level
- Working with the treasurer to devise an annual budget for the region
- Liaising with volunteers across the region to establish achievable goals for the EMEA region to work towards
