The Role

Robogals is seeking a new global Deputy Chief Operations Officer (dCOO) to support the growth and operations of the Robogals community and leading the operations team to meet organisational targets. Candidates must have a passion for inspiring girls and women about careers in engineering and building a culture of diversity and inclusion in engineering.

The dCOO reports to the Chief Operations Officer (COO) and is responsible for:

- Identifying new projects for the Operations team to work on in line with the strategic vision of the organisation
- Managing and mentoring the Operations team
- Development and execution of operational activities and processes within the organization in line
- Taking the role of Acting COO in the absence of the COO

Skills Required

The successful candidate will require:

- Leadership experience demonstrated by management of a team/s
- Management experience demonstrated by delivery of successful projects
- Problem solving and critical thinking skills
- Communication skills

The successful candidate will have or be developing:

- Systematic approach to complex projects.
- Big picture thinking to challenge the status quo and create innovative approaches to support Robogals moving forward.
