The Role

Robogals is seeking an individual as the new Asia Pacific Partnerships Director to lead the APAC Partnerships team and support and grow our partnership portfolio. The successful candidate will be an individual passionate about the Robogals mission who shares the organisation's values (see www.robogals.org/about/about-us/) and has the ability to lead, communicate professionally and use initiative. The role will involve managing the partnerships team, liaising with new potential partners, developing and implementing partnerships strategy, and working on key partnership projects. Please note this is a voluntary role.

Responsibilities

The Partnership Director reports to the Asia Pacific Regional Executive Officer (REO) and is responsible for:

- Managing, leading, and supporting the partnerships team.
- Developing and implementing the APAC Partnerships Strategy
- Key partnership projects such as the annual prospectus and development of communication and reporting tools.
- Networking with potential partners to grow the APAC partnerships portfolio.
- Working with the broader Regional Team, and reporting to the REO and CEO.
- Improving internal collaboration with Chapter Partnership Managers.

Although a voluntary position, the successful candidate will have opportunities to gain leadership experience in an international organization, develop soft skills, attend the Robogals APAC annual conference, and attend industry partner events on invitation.

Skills Required

The successful candidate will require:

- The ability to take initiative to improve or develop projects and strategies.
- Strong time management skills and the ability to multi task.
- Engaging and professional communication skills across a variety of mediums with a range of different people.
- Past leadership experience and/or project management experience demonstrated through paid, volunteering or school/university leadership roles
- Past experience working in the partnerships space or with industry is desirable, but not required.

Applicants for this position will be reviewed based on their passion towards the organisational goals, the required skills outlined, and relevance to role responsibilities.
