The Role

Additionally, the REO sits on the Global Leadership team, and in this capacity contributes towards the overall strategy, global projects, and representation of the APAC region at the global level, The successful candidate will be an individual passionate about the Robogals mission who shares the organisation's values (see www.robogals.org/about/about-us/) and has the ability to lead, communicate professionally, manage time effectively and use initiative. Please note this is a voluntary role.

Responsibilities

The APAC REO reports directly to the Robogals CEO, and is responsible for:

- Managing, leading, and supporting the Asia Pacific Regional team.
- Developing and implementing the APAC Region Strategy
- Managing and supporting regional chapters, partnerships, and initiatives through the regional team
- Managing regional finances with the support of the APAC team and CFO.
- Managing transparency of the region with the board, leadership team, and chapters.
- Assisting in the organisation of APAC events and initiatives.
- Deliver new projects to benefit the region and global organisation.

Remuneration

The APAC Regional Executive Officer is a voluntary position, however does offer several benefits, including:
