Robogals is an international, not-for-profit organisation that aims to inspire, engage and empower young women into engineering and related fields. This is achieved through fun and educational initiatives aimed at girls in primary and secondary school. Since inception in 2008, Robogals has inspired over 70,000 girls globally. The APAC Initiatives Team is responsible for programs which engage students with Robogals beyond an initial workshop. Our current two programs are Science Challenge, a competition for girls between the ages of 5 – 15, and Pathway into Engineering, a resource based program currently under development.

The Role

Robogals is currently seeking an individual to take on the new role of Deputy Project Director. The purpose of this role is to assist in the management and operations of the initiatives team and its programs which are growing in scale. The role will involve working closely with the current Project Director, to develop the team strategy, support members of the initiatives team, and coordinate projects and team operations. Additionally, the role will also explore the expansion of current, upcoming and new initiatives. The successful candidate will be an individual passionate about the Robogals mission who shares the organisation's values, and has the ability to coordinate a team, manage time effectively, and communicate professionally. Please note this is a voluntary role.

Responsibilities

- Help manage the initiative's team's tasking, schedules and budgets
- Provide support and leadership to the initiatives team
- Work on the expansion and delivery of current and new initiative programs.
- Working and collaborating with the Development, Regional, Operational and Chapter teams to deliver your accountabilities.

Although a voluntary position, the successful candidate will have opportunities to make a tremendous impact on young girls' lives, gain experience in a leadership position on an international organization, and the opportunity to attend the Robogals APAC annual volunteer development and networking conference.
