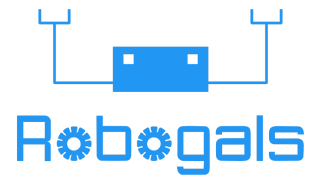

The Role

Robogals is seeking new members for the Development team to support the growth and development of the Robogals community. Candidates will have a passion for inspiring girls and women about careers in engineering and building a culture of diversity and inclusion in engineering.

The role allows you to contribute to providing strategic guidance in the development of training and community within the organisation and manage related initiatives.

Development Managers report to the Chief Development Officer (CDO) and are responsible for:

- The execution of at least one of the following projects in a supporting or managing role:
 - Impact Measurement
 - SET (Self Evaluation Tool)
 - Professional Development
 - Culture Book
 - Recruitment Pipeline
- Assisting with organisation of a SINE (Seminar for Inducting New Executives) conference in one region

In this role, you will also have the opportunity to develop your own projects such as:

- Initiating training and community initiatives for Robogals executives at a chapter, regional, and global level
- Developing training, outreach communication, and community strategies

Required Skills

- Initiative and creativity
- Critical thinking, planning, and communication skills
- Time management and the ability to multitask
- Ability to see projects through from planning to evaluation and handover
- Integrity, an embodiment of the Robogals values
- Big picture thinking to challenge the status quo and create innovative approaches to support Robogals moving forward
