The Role

You will be assisted by a Deputy Regional Executive Officer (dREO). The dREO and REO roles are intended to complement one another, making use of the individual's respective strengths to lead, support, and grow the region effectively.

The successful candidate will be an individual passionate about the Robogals mission who shares the organisations values (see www.robogals.org/about/about-us/) and has the ability to lead, communicate professionally, manage time effectively and use initiative. Please note this is a voluntary role.
