The Role

Robogals is seeking a bright individual as the new global Chief Technical Officer (CTO) to support and grow the technical aspects of the organisation. A successful candidate possesses a strong programming and/or technical background and your values should align with Robogals organisational goals (see <https://robogals.org/about/about-us/>). The role will involve overseeing all technical aspects of the organisation which will include maintaining current systems and developing new tools within the organisation to improve current processes.

The CTO reports to the Chief Operations Officer (COO) and is responsible for:

- Managing a geographically dispersed technical team
- Leading and creating the technology strategy for the organisation including scoping and delegating to the team
- Updating the leadership team on current events happening in the technical team
- Answer any technical questions from the organization
- Make sure that any critical technical issues get resolved as soon as possible

Required Skills

- Have used or know of agile product development
- Have strong working knowledge of github
- Demonstrate strong project management skills through previous leadership roles
- Possess a strong technical background

Nice to Have:

- A strong programming background including familiarity with django, python and php
- Up-to-date with the newest technologies to develop and grow Robogals in the tech space
