The Role

Alongside other Chapter Support Team members, you will support chapters to achieve their team and individual goals, and be the primary link between Robogals chapters in your region and the Regional team. In particular you will act as a mentor for chapter Presidents. The successful candidate will be an individual passionate about the Robogals mission who shares the organisation's values, and has the ability to take initiative, communicate in a professional and engaging manner with a variety of people, and manage projects to support chapters. Chapter experience is preferred. Please note this is a voluntary role.

Responsibilities

- Mentoring chapter presidents and chapter executives to achieve their goals.
- Representing chapter interests at the regional level.
- Working with the Chapter Support Team to develop new initiatives to further assist chapters.
- Working with other areas of the regional team on projects that affect chapters.
- Assistance in the organisation of the Robogals SINE conference.

Although a voluntary position, the successful candidate will have opportunities to gain project management and mentoring experience in an international organisation, network with industry, and the opportunity to attend the Robogals APAC annual volunteer conference.

Skills Required

The successful candidate will require:

- Ability to communicate clearly to a range of people through a variety of media
- Strategic thinking, forward planning, and initiative in supporting and advising chapters
- Embodiment of Robogals values, and ability to mentor others to do the same
